



All you need to do is wash & sterilize the lids and leave to dry. Choose photos that will mean something to your baby and will encourage conversation. These could be pictures of themselves, of family, pets or familiar objects. Place the lid over the picture and draw around the photo. Cut out the photo and cover in sticky back plastic or sellotape so this can be cleaned if your baby puts them in their mouth. Glue the picture inside and once dry offer these to your baby.

### What you need to get started:

- Clean & sterilized lids from jars of varying sizes
- Photos of your family / baby
- Pen, scissors and glue to stick the photo in the lid
- Stickers or pictures to go on the other side
- Sellotape/sticky back plastic to cover the photos so they are wipe clean

# Faces to play with!

**Homemade projects are not only lots of fun, but they are also beneficial to encourage your baby to learn to communicate and encourage movement together**



This is a great tummy time activity, by placing them in front of your baby it will encourage them to stretch and reach. It will also support their fine motor skills and hand /eye development. Talk to your baby about the people in the photos and, talk about their emotions, are they happy, smiling, grandma loves your smile etc. As your baby grows you could make a whole family album! You can also introduce a tissue box to create a 'posting lids' game. As your baby gets older and their concentration develops, use the lids as a memory game. Turn the lids over and ask them if they can remember where the picture of 'Mummy' is etc. You could add colours to the back of the lids to help with memory and recognition too. The activities and skills that can be developed through this game are endless.
