

Make a fun and easy nature crown

Explore the outdoors and create a fun and easy nature crown out of natural materials.

You will need:

- Double sided tape
- Brown card or paper
- Scissors
- Mix of leaves, sticks, twigs, leaves, grass or twine

Fun facts on the Queen's crown

- The crown symbolises the sovereignty of the monarch of the United Kingdom.
- The current version was made in 1937 and is on public display at the Tower of London.
- It is made up many precious gems including 2,868 diamonds, 273 pearls, 17 sapphires, 11 emeralds, and 5 rubies.

Method:

- Step outside! Visit your local green space, woodland park or back garden.
- Try to collect different coloured items in your area.
- Lay out the items you've found.
- Take out your piece of card.
- Roll out the double sided tape and stick it to the card.
- Place and stick your items over the top of each other!
- Try to mix and match the colours and shades for a truly bright and bold nature crown.
- Ask an older explorer to create a small hole in the end of the card.
- Place your crown around your head and fasten the crown using some strong grass or twine.



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
